CORRECTION

2013 REVIEW OF PARLIAMENTARY CONSTITUENCIES - INITIAL PROPOSALS

This Correction relates to the Initial Proposals under the 2013 Review of Parliamentary Constituencies published in January 2012 by the Boundary Commission for Wales (the Commission). The publication can be found on the Commission's website www.bcomm-wales.gov.uk.

The Commission would like to make a correction to what is stated in the initial proposals report in relation to the proposed Alyn and Deeside constituency. The Commission states in paragraph 6.146 that "previously Mold had been in the former Alyn and Deeside District". This was intended to refer to the position in 1973 when the district was formed under the Local Government Act 1972. In fact it is not correct that Mold was part of this district and the Commission apologises for this error.

However, this was not a determining factor for the creation of this proposed constituency. By including Mold and the electoral divisions to the South and East of Mold, a constituency would be created which would be within the statutory electorate range. Furthermore, it would contain electoral divisions which are all within the county of Flintshire.

The Commission's initial proposals are open for public consultation until 4 April 2012
